



## Lake Forest Boat Ramp Parking – Frequently Asked Questions

When our boat trailer parking areas become full, we request that our customers **DO NOT PARK** on Lake Forest Road or neighboring streets. Blocking driveways or impeding emergency access can result in being cited, towed or both. Boat trailer parking is not permitted on Hwy 28 and will be enforced by local law enforcement.

### What can I do if I believe someone is blocking my driveway or impeding emergency access?

California Highway Patrol is the agency responsible for responding to parking violations. These violations include blocking the roadway, blocking a driveway, parking within 15 feet of a fire hydrant, and blocking flow or emergency equipment access.
